

# **Intramural Swim Meet Rules- Fall 2009**

**Thursday, November 12, 2009 @ Texas Swim Center  
Warm-ups from 6:30pm-7:15pm – Meet starts at 7:30pm**

## **Order of events**

**200 medley relay, 200 free, 50 free, 100 IM, 50 fly, 200 coed inner tube relay, 100 free, 50 back, 400 free, 50 breast, 200 free relay**

**All participants will enter events by submitting the Entry Form on deck between 6:30-7:00pm at the meet.**

- 1) Each individual, either unattached or with a team, may enter 3 swimming events plus the inner tube relay.
- 2) Teams may enter a maximum of 4 swimmers per individual event, and 1 team per relay event.
- 3) Teams shall consist of a minimum of 4 swimmers and a maximum of 12 swimmers. Note: There must be 4 swimmers or 2 relay teams in order to hold an event for points and prizes.
- 4) Scoring for each event will be for the top 8 times as follows: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1. Relays will also be scored using this system. The inner tube relay will not count for points, and any 4 swimmers (2 male/2 female) may participate.
- 5) Teams may replace current roster swimmers with different swimmers prior to 7:15pm on deck. No additional swimmers may be added.
- 6) Unattached swimmers may form teams to compete for team points and/or to compete in relay events at the meet.
- 7) University of Texas Intercollegiate Athletes and any collegiate letter winners in swimming are not eligible for the Intramural Swim meet. 2008-09 and 2009-10 UTSCA roster members for men's and women's Water Polo are limited to 2 swimmers per team, including relays.
- 8) Swimmers are responsible for reporting to the proper lane as their events are called. Heat sheets will be posted by 7:30pm.
- 9) Awards – The overall winner of each event will receive an Intramural Champion T-shirt. The winning men's and women's teams will also receive an Intramural Champion T-shirt. All awards will be presented at the conclusion of the meet.
- 10) Photos of the men's and women's team champions will be taken for the Wall of Fame. Participants must be present at the conclusion of the meet for the photo.
